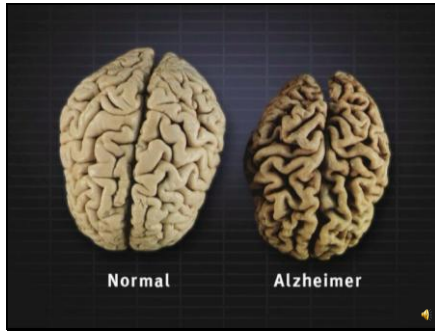

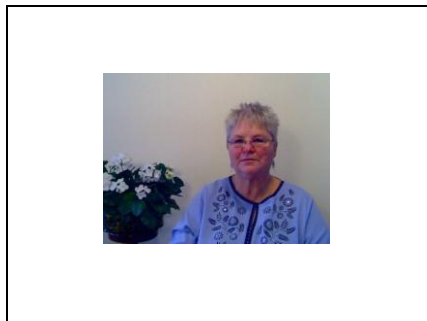
DEMENTIA – What is it??

- GROUP OF SYMPTOMS
 - Short Term Memory Recall and Loss
 - Impairment in thinking and comprehension
 - Loss of Abilities
 - Communication which leads to the loss of ability to understand what we say and loss of ability to speak to us
 - Decision Making which leads to the loss of feeling like they are in control
 - Personal Care Tasks which leads to their loss of ability to dress, groom, bathe, toilet and feed themselves
 - Strength and Mobility which leads to their loss of ability to stand, transfer and ambulate
 - Emotions and Impulse Control which leads to behavioral symptoms

DEMENTIA – What is it?? – con't

- **TYPES of Dementia**
 - Reversible Type – symptoms are reversed after treatment.
 - Examples: depression, delirium, medications, toxicity
 - Irreversible Type – symptoms are NOT reversed – are permanent
- **OVER 80 Different Kinds (Irreversible)**
 - Rare kinds such as Pick's Disease, Lewy Body, Korsocoff's disease
 - Common kinds such as Alzheimer's disease and Multi-Infarct (Vascular) dementia.
